Subject: New Manufacture Date Codes August 2014

Due to restrictions imposed on us by one of the sensor manufactures we have to change the manufacture data code format we use on our sensors.

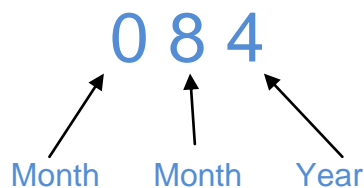
Crowcon's old date code format consisted of a 3 digit number that references the week, week, year for example 409 was week 40 of 2009.

City Technology sensors have changed their format to **MMY** (month, month, year), and has been supplying sensors for at least a month prior to the date of this technical note with the new format. City Tech. sensors can be identified where the date format has changed from serial number **27640980** onwards.

We have decided to use this date format for all our sensors including **Alphasense** and therefore from the **4th August 2014**, Crowcon will implement a new standard date code format for all items produced. We will confirm the Alphasense "start" serial number in the near future.

New date code from August 2014:

The first 2 digits correspond to the month of manufacture and the third denotes the year of manufacture.



084 = Month 8 (August) of 2014

Please note there will be some parts that retain the older format while we work through our stock.
